

NAME	BREWERY	ABV	TASTING NOTES
BATHAMS	Bathams Bitter	4.3%	A straw coloured bitter which initially seems sweet, but a complex dry, hoppy taste by using fuggles, golding hops and maris otter malt, soon predominates. Probably the best example of a lack country style of bitter.
BENDIGEDIG BITTER	FACER'S	4.3%	Golden in colour, with a rich smooth full fruity palate and after taste. The nose is delightfully hoppy, derived from the late addition of first gold hops.
BRIMSTAGE	TRAPPER'S HAT	3.8%	Winners of Birkenhead beer Festival for 3 years. Gold coloured with complex bouquet, providing a mouthful of fruit zest with hints of orange and grapefruit. Refreshingly hoppy brew, derived from a variety of Slovenian and English hops.
Celtica	(Great Orm)		A refreshing contemporary cask conditioned golden ale full of citrus taste and aroma. This ale is brewed using single pale ale malt giving at a lovely golden colour. Citrus flavoured hops are used during the boil to produce an intense fruity flavour, which is often enjoyed as a more flavoursome alternative to lager.
COACH HOUSE	COACHMANS	3.7%	Smooth, full-bodied cask conditioned beer, with a rich malty flavour balanced by the aroma and flavour of golding hops.
CLOGWYN GOLD	Conwy brewery	3.7%	A light, quaffable golden ale with plenty of hop aroma and a long bitter finish. A very tasty beer for its strength.
Dark Side of the Moose	Purple Moose	4.6%	A dark ale with deep malt flavour and a fruity bitterness.

Dizzy Blonde	Robinsons	3.8%	Straw coloured Summer Ale with distinctive herbal or perfume like hop aroma. This light refreshing beer has a clean zesty hop dominated palate complimented by a crisp dry finish?

FLINTSHIRE BITTER	FACER'S	3.7%	A light copper coloured ale with a perfect blend of malt and fruitiness on the palate, derived from first gold hops.

Hartley's	XB	4.0%	Pale tart beer brewed to Hartley's original recipe. Famed for its rich rounded body, smooth bitterness and subtle tang of malt. Long dry slightly acidic finish with fruit notes.
JOSEPH HOLT'S	Bitter	4.0%	Copper coloured beer made with a combination of targets bodecia and fuggles hops. Giving it a fruity and malty aroma and also hops malt and fruit in taste, finishing with a distinct bitterness.
LITTLE BOLLINGTON	DUNHAM MASSEY	3.7%	Is a pale light easy drinking bitter, made from fuggles and goldings hops with halcyon and crystal malt.
Madog	Purple Moose	3.7%	A crisp, malty amber red ale with a dry bitter finish.

RAMPART	Conwy Brewery	4.5 %	Enticing floral aromas of fuggles are followed by smooth spicy/citrus flavours of goldings hops. Dark malts give a dark amber hue to this fine ale and create a lasting, memorable finish
REVEREND JAMES	Brains Cardiff brewery	4,5%	Full-bodied and warming, The Rev James is rich in palate, spicy and aromatic with a deeply satisfying finish.
Punk IPA	Brewdog, Aberdeenshire	6%	A beer of inherent contradiction this heavy weight of the beer world is strikingly delicate with a white gold appearance

Unicorn	Robinsons	4.2%	Magnificent pale tart and thirst quenching bitter beer. Superb mouth feel of rich malt and hops and complex aromas of golding hops, malt and tart fruit. Long dry finish with citrus fruit notes. Gold Medal Winner at the Brewing Industry International Awards.
WEETWOOD	OLD DOG	4.5%	A robust, well balanced amber beer with a slightly fruity aroma. Rich malt and fruit flavours are balanced by brightness along with some sweetness and a hint of sulphur on the nose and taste.
Welsh Pride	Conwy	4%	Copper in colour with a rich malty taste followed by an orangey/spicy finish.
